It is not correct that one should overburden oneself by meticulously following timetables based upon astronomical calculations. Rather the Sunnah is ease, and this timetable is merely an approximate guide. See '*Majmū' al-Fatāwā*' of Shaykhul-Islām Ibn Taymiyyah (25/126- 202), '*Al-Majmū'*' of an-Nawawī (6/279), '*At-Talkhisul-Habir*' of Ibn Hajr (2/187-188).
